Congratulations once again to **Andrew** as the winner of this past season's Urshan/Lerner Award.

Congratulations too to **Jack Nicholl** as a silver medal winner (aka the "Non-Urshan Award") and as the winner of the just-created Rookie of the Season award. In fact, if the stats DID include players' records as a sub, Jack would have taken the top spot with a 14.57 rating.

Points are based on a system that tracks wins and losses giving higher credit for higher courts. The stats of subs don't count toward the points for each player. So whether you had a sub, or you served as a sub, those points don't affect your season points results. [FYI, if you're really curious about this, I do have ratings and results available that include "as-a-sub" results.]
